Categories of dental treatment:

Emergency Treatment:

To be performed for potentially life threatening conditions and require immediate treatment to stop ongoing tissue bleeding, alleviate severe pain or infection, and include:

- 1) Uncontrolled bleeding
- 2) Cellulitis or a diffuse soft tissue bacterial infection with intra-oral or extra-oral swelling that potentially compromise the patient's airway
- 3) Trauma involving facial bones, potentially compromising the patient's airway
- 4) Control of bleeding- Due to facial/dental trauma
- 5) Simple extractions to alleviate prolonged dental pain and infection (medically managed with antibiotics and analgesics)
- 6) Incision and drainage of localized dental abscess
- 7) Access opening using spoon excavator or micro motor and pulp extirpation to alleviate dental pain from fractured tooth/Deep dental caries

Urgent Dental Treatment:

- 1) Temporary/Interim restorations to alleviate pain and sensitivity
- 2) Crown/Bridge cementations
- 3) Biopsy
- 4) Denture adjustments
- 5) Routine Orthodontic follow-up
- 6) Radiological services

Note: These procedures may be taken up eventually
